(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #1:



- Adhere the Silver Foil frame to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Wrap a 10" piece of Crushed Curry Twine around your fingers to create a loose circle, then arrange the twine circle on the front of the card. Adhere the Heart print paper banner to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals. (This will secure the twine.)
- Cut a banner shape from a 2-1/2" x 1/2" piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock; stamp hearts in

Crushed Curry ink on the banner; adhere to the paper banner.

- Stamp "The little things" on the chevron paper heart in Tuxedo Black ink; adhere the heart to the banner using Stampin' Dimensionals; attach a silver Mini Metallic Clothespin.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #2:

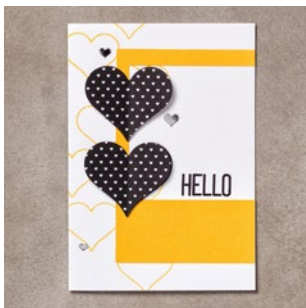


- Adhere the small hearts frame to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Wrap an 8" piece of Crushed Curry Twine around your fingers to create a loose circle, then arrange the twine circle on the front of the card.
- Cut a banner shape from a 2-1/2" x 1/2" piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock; adhere the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals. (This will secure the twine.)

- Stamp "So sweet" on the chevron paper heart in Tuxedo Black ink, then adhere the stamped heart to the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner using Fast Fuse. Adhere the Silver Foil heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

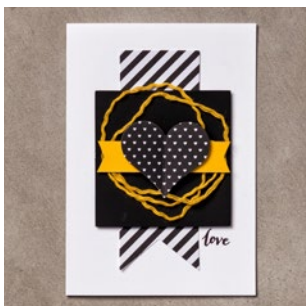
CARD #3:



- Using the Stampin' Trimmer, remove about 1/4" from the right side of the Crushed Curry Cardstock frame.
- Stamp the heart images in Crushed Curry ink on the front of the card, then adhere the Crushed Curry Cardstock frame to the front of the card.
- Stamp "Hello" in Tuxedo Black ink on the front of the card.
- Adhere the chalkboard paper hearts to the front of the card. Fold the printed paper hearts in half and adhere them over the black hearts at the fold line using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Adhere the silver foil heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #4:



- Adhere the striped paper banner to the front of the card. Adhere the chalkboard paper square to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Cut a 12" piece of Crushed Curry Twine; unravel the twine into three pieces. Wrap one piece of the twine around your fingers to create a loose circle, then arrange the twine circle on the front of chalkboard paper square.
- Cut a banner shape from a 2-1/2" x 1/2" piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock; adhere the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner to the Basic Black Cardstock square using Stampin' Dimensionals. (This will secure the twine.)
- Adhere a chalkboard paper heart to the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner. Fold a printed paper heart in half and adhere it over the black Cardstock heart at the fold line using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Stamp "Love" in Tuxedo Black ink on the front of the card.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #5:



- Cut off about 1/4" from the left side of the black frame. Using a pencil, lightly outline the frame on the front of the card, then stamp hearts in Crushed Curry ink within the outlined space. Erase the pencil lines and adhere the black frame to the card.
- Stamp "Love" in Whisper White Craft ink on the black frame.
- Cut a banner shape from a 2-1/2" x 1/2" piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock and adhere it to the front of the card.
- Cut a 2" x 1/4" piece from the striped paper scraps. Adhere it to the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner.
- Adhere the Silver Foil heart to the banner using Stampin' Dimensionals .
- Adhere the Crushed Curry Cardstock heart accent to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #6:



- Stamp hearts in Crushed Curry ink on the Crushed Curry Cardstock square. Adhere the square to the front of the card using Fast Fuse.
- Adhere the chevron paper heart accent to the front of the card using Fast Fuse.
- Adhere the black heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Adhere the self-adhesive letters to the front of the card.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #7:



- Adhere the Silver Foil square to the front of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Adhere the Crushed Curry Cardstock (punched hearts) banner to the front of the card.
- Stamp "Hello" on the chevron paper heart in Tuxedo Black ink. Adhere the heart to the front of the card.
- Adhere self-adhesive letters to the front of the card.
- Cut a 6" piece of Whisper White Baker's Twine and tie a bow; adhere the bow to the front of the card using a dot of Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE TWO EACH)

CARD #8:



- Stamp hearts on the front of the card using Crushed Curry and Tuxedo Black inks; stamp “So sweet” in Crushed Curry ink on the striped paper banner. Adhere the banner to the front of the card using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Adhere the Silver Foil heart to the banner using Fast Fuse.

- Cut a 6” piece of Crushed Curry Twine; unravel the twine into three pieces. Use one piece to make a bow. Adhere the bow to the card using a dot of Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE ONE EACH)

CARD #9:



- Stamp the heart in Crushed Curry ink on the front of the card. Stamp the sentiment in Tuxedo Black ink on the front of the card.
- Adhere heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Wrap a 28” piece of Whisper White Baker’s Twine around the card twice; tie a bow.

(MAKE ONE EACH)

CARD #10:



- Cut the Designer Series Paper (chevron) rectangle in half and adhere it to the front of the card. (The other half will be used for card #11.)
- Stamp “Hello life” in Crushed Curry ink on the Designer Series Paper (chevron) rectangle.
- Cut a banner shape from a 4-1/4” x 1-1/2” piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock. Adhere it to the front of the card.

- Adhere the Silver Foil heart to the Designer Series Paper (stripes) heart; adhere the hearts to the front of the card using Stampin’ Dimensionals .
- Cut the Crushed Curry Baker’s Twine in half; tie a small bow. (The rest of the Crushed Curry Baker’s Twine will be used for card #11.)
- Add the Crushed Curry Baker’s Twine bow and the mini heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE ONE EACH)

CARD #11:



- Carefully apply ink to the stamp using Whisper White Craft ink; ink only the word “Happy.” Stamp the chalkboard paper heart. Set aside to dry.
- Adhere the remaining half of the Designer Series Paper (chevron) rectangle to the front of the card. (See card #10.)
- Cut a banner shape from a 4-1/4” x 1-1/2” piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock. Adhere it to the front of the card.

- Cut a 4” x 1/4” piece from the Designer Series Paper (stripes) scraps. Adhere it to the Crushed Curry Cardstock banner.
- Adhere the heart to the front of the card using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Use the remaining Crushed Curry Baker’s Twine to make a small bow. (See card #10.)
- Add the Crushed Curry Baker’s Twine bow and the mini heart accents to the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

(MAKE ONE EACH)

CARD #12:



- Adhere the Window Sheet to the back of the Designer Series Paper heart frame using Fast Fuse; adhere the Shaker Frame adhesive to the back.
- Punch out all of the remaining heart accents; place them in the center of the card.
- Peel off the Shaker Frame adhesive backing and place the heart frame over the heart confetti; line up the sides of the Designer Series Paper (stripes) heart frame with the sides of card and trim.

- Adhere the Silver Foil heart to the card using Fast Fuse.
- Cut a banner shape from a 3-1/2” x 1/2” piece of Crushed Curry Cardstock. Stamp “Hello” in Tuxedo Black ink and adhere the banner to the front of the card using Fast Fuse.
